

- Suzanne had the "Engineer Sub"




<u>What is the project?</u>

- We were given the challenge of designing an exhibit that would educate the public about wind as an alternative energy source.


First Sponsor Meeting

 - Complexity





 Design a museum exhibit to demonstrate the abilities of wind energy to the general public of all ages.


